This authority is subject to:

1. Approval of the Central West Livestock Health & Pest Authority for a Grazing Permit under Section 101 of the Rural Lands Protection Act 1989
2. All stock grazed under this authority meeting all requirements of the Rural Lands Protection Act 1989 and the Stock Disease Act 1923.
3. The requirements of Council's Tree Preservation Order which states that a person shall not, except with the consent of the Council, ring-bark, cut down, top, lop, remove, injure or willfully destroy any trees which:
 - a) is or are greater than 3.0 meters in height;
 - OR**
 - b) has or have a branch spread greater than 2.4 meters.
4. Relevant copies of Public Liability Insurance cover to the value of \$20,000,000.00.
5. Stock signs must be displayed either end of roadway being grazed and a person in attendance at all times.
6. Stock to be removed from road reserve in event of road closures following rain.
7. Stock are not to be left on public road after dark.
8. The permit is normally limited to a period not exceeding two weeks or as indicated by the Livestock Health and Pest Authority
