### **PENSIONERS' RATE CONCESSIONS**

To enable Council to allocate correct rebates to pensioners, all persons who hold a **PENSIONER CONCESSION CARD**, including any new card holders, are requested to bring their card to the Council Office for sighting and notation if they have not already done so. For those who cannot bring the card personally, it may be sent by mail or messenger. Until cards are presented the rebate on rates cannot be given. **For pensioners living at Gulargambone they may take their card to the RTC where it will be copied free of charge and the copy forwarded to Council.**

### **WHEEL STOPS IN COONAMBLE CBD**

Over the past weeks Council has noted that many of the wheel stops in the Castlereagh Street business precinct have been damaged – it intends to replace the damaged stops and repaint the line markings. Council is asking residents to endeavor to park correctly within the lines and for those with heavy vehicles to refrain from backing over the wheel stops.
