ILLEGAL DUMPING OF RUBBISH

There have been significant increases recently in incidents of illegal dumping of rubbish in and around Coonamble and Gulargambone, as well as along roads and on stock routes within the Shire. **Littering is an offence - offenders will be fined \$220 for the first offence. Surveillance cameras have been installed in strategic areas around both centres.**

COMPANION ANIMALS

Council continues to receive numerous complaints concerning breaches of the Companion Animals Act. **IF YOU HAVE ANIMALS NOT MICROCHIPPED AND REGISTERED – NOW'S THE TIME TO TAKE ACTION – OTHERWISE YOU RISK A FINE!!!** Another concern that Council has is the amount of complaints received concerning barking dogs – the complaints come mostly from neighbours or people living in the vicinity of the offending dogs. Pet owners are again requested to take proper care of their animals – generally dogs won't bark if they are properly housed and fed. **THE ONUS IS ON THE OWNER – LOOK AFTER YOUR DOGS – CONTINUED COMPLAINTS WILL LEAD TO FINES BEING ISSUED. PLEASE DON'T SAY YOU DIDN'T KNOW!!!**
