ILLEGAL DUMPING OF RUBBISH

There have been significant increases recently in incidents of illegal dumping of rubbish in and around Coonambale and Gulargambone, as well as along roads and on stock routes within the Shire. **Littering is an offence - offenders will be fined \$220 for the first offence. Surveillance cameras have been installed in strategic areas around both centres.**
