### **RESTRICTED USE OF WATER – COONAMBLE**

An extremely high demand on Council's water supplies has resulted in water restrictions being imposed in Coonamble to ensure that the supply meets residents' needs. Residents are asked to ensure fixed hoses and sprinklers are used only between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and 8.00 a.m. Compliance with these restrictions will be monitored by Council Officers. Under the Local Government Act 1993 the maximum penalty for a breach of imposed water restrictions is \$2,200 for corporations and \$220 for individuals. ### **REGISTRATION OF SWIMMING POOLS**

#### **INCLUDES IN-GROUND, ABOVE GROUND, SPAS, KIDDIE SPLASH POOLS (E.G SHELL POOLS), PORTABLE, INFLATABLE & DEMOUNTABLE POOLS.**

Council is asking all residents with private swimming pools to ensure they are registered on the NSW State Government's online register ([www.swimmingpoolregister.nsw.gov.au](http://www.swimmingpoolregister.nsw.gov.au)). ***Failing to do so could incur a \$220 fine.*** Any pool that is capable of being filled with water to a depth of 30cm or more requires a pool fence (child-resistant barrier). If the capacity of the pool or spa exceeds 2,000 litres it requires Council approval before installation, filling or use.

### **LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANTS COMMISSION**

Members of the Local Government Grants Commission will visit Coonamble on Wednesday 27 February. The group will meet with Councillors at 1.30 p.m. in the Council Chamber to explain its operations and the basis of its calculation of financial assistance grants. The meeting also gives Council the opportunity to present its circumstances to the Commission. It is expected that the meeting will

last approximately two hours. Interested members of the public are invited to the meeting.

**AMENDED TIME FOR COLLECTION OF POTABLE WATER**

Eligible rural residents are entitled to collect potable water for domestic use from Council's standpipes in the three urban areas. The time for collection of the water from the **Coonamble standpipe** has been changed – please note it is now available from **10.00 a.m. until 12 noon on TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS**. Gulargambone and Quambone times remain unchanged.
