RESTRICTED USE OF WATER – COONAMBLE

Restricted times for the use of water in Coonamble still apply. Residents are asked to ensure fixed hoses and sprinklers are used only between the hours of 8.00 p.m. and 8.00 a.m. Compliance with these restrictions will be monitored by Council Officers. Under the Local Government Act 1993 the maximum penalty for a breach of imposed water restrictions is \$2,200 for corporations and \$220 for individuals.
