COMPANION ANIMALS - MESSAGE FROM THE NSW GOVERNMENT

Are you **SELLING** or **GIVING AWAY** a **CAT** or **DOG**? The rules have changed. **FROM 1 JULY 2019** any advertisements will need to include either:

- a) **microchip number;**
- b) **breeder identification number or**
- c) **rehoming organisation number.**

It doesn't matter:

- i) how old the animal is;
- ii) where you want to advertise;
- iii) whether you are a hobby or professional breeder; or your cat or dog has had an accidental or 'one-off' litter;
- iv) whether or not you bred the animal;
- v) whether or not the animal you are selling or rehoming has been born yet.
