Western NSW Local Health District remains at 47 confirmed cases of COVID-19.

A case of COVID-19 has been reported in the Parkes Local Government Area, however testing in the community has not returned any evidence of community transmission and precautionary measures put in place can now be removed. The case is currently in isolation and contact has been made with all 18 close contacts, who have undergone testing with negative results.

The Local Health District says it's a timely reminder for all of us that our region isn't immune to COVID-19 and we need to keep practising all the measures we know are effective, including :

- If you are unwell stay in, get tested and isolate.
- Wash your hands regularly. Take hand sanitiser with you when you go out.
- Keep your distance. Leave 1.5 metres between yourself and others.
- Wear a mask in situations where you cannot physically distance.

Right now, the message from the Local Health District is very simple – if you have any symptoms, even mild ones, arrange to be tested.
