## **ROAD CONDITIONS REPORT – UNSEALED ROADS OPEN WITH CAUTION**

Coonamble Shire Council advises the travelling public that **ALL UNSEALED ROADS** within the Local Government Area are **OPEN** to all traffic, requesting that drivers exercise caution and drive to conditions at all times.

Road users are reminded that:

- 1. They may be liable for any damage that they cause to the road that is closed to their vehicle type.
- 2. Travelling on roads covered with water is extremely dangerous and should be avoided.
- 3. Road conditions can change without warning and, if roads are open, drivers should travel with caution.
- 4. Unsealed roads damage very easily when they are wet.
- 5. Repairs to damaged roads are not usually possible until the roads and gravel stockpiles begin to dry out.
- 6. Council prioritises repairs, with higher trafficked roads usually receiving attention first.
- 7. Emergency vehicles are exempt from this directive, in the course of responding to legitimate emergencies.

Council appreciates the restraint and patience of rural landholders in minimising road use while unsealed roads have been closed.

Council staff periodically inspect roads during and after rain events and issue updated road bulletins as conditions change.
