ROAD CONDITIONS UPDATE - ALL UNSEALED ROADS OPEN WITH CAUTION

Coonamble Shire Council advises the travelling public that **UNSEALED ROADS** within the Local Government Area are open to all vehicles, with drivers asked to exercise caution and to drive to conditions.

Traffic driving on unsealed roads may encounter such hazards as boggy patches and water lying in causeways.

On the sealed road network, work is progressing on culvert replacement on the Castlereagh Highway north of Coonamble at Glenhaven. Traffic advisory signs are in place along Pilliga Road through the causeways north of the Floddenfield Road intersection and about 10km west of Gulargambone on the Gulargambone Road.

All drivers should be mindful of rough surfaces and broken edges on sealed roads following recent rainfall and the impact of heavy vehicles.

Council staff periodically inspect roads during and after rain events and issue updated road bulletins as conditions change.
