Quotations requested for road projects throughout the area

Council is calling for quotations for significant work on Back Gular Road, Box Ridge Road and Quabathoo Road.

About five kilometres of Back Gular will be resurfaced in two sections of work.

Flood damage repair is planned for 300m of Box Ridge Road, east of Gulargambone.

Two floodways are to be reconstructed along Quabathoo Road.

Meanwhile, as part of Council's roads program, culvert replacement on the Castlereagh Highway continues about 50km north of Coonamble.

Traffic control will be in place, reducing traffic to single-lane movement in some locations while work is carried out.

Resheeting work continues on Bramble Road in the south-east. Maintenance grading continues on

Gulargambone Road, west of town.

About seven kilometres of Mungery Road has been reformed, and resheeting and regrading is now scheduled.

Maintenance grading on Goorinawa Road is also planned.

Progress of Council's roads program is subject to favourable weather conditions and can be delayed by wet weather events and the time needed for roads to dry out.

Council's next Ordinary Meeting will be at the Gulargambone Memorial Hall in Bourbah Street, Gulargambone, on Wednesday, 10 March, from 10am.
