Finalisation of the work on Bramble Road has also been held up by the recent rain.

Work to replace culverts along the Castlereagh Highway north of Coonamble has also been delayed.

While many unsealed roads have been opened to light traffic this week, there may still be spots where caution is required. Residents and travellers are requested to drive with care at all times.
